Class 167. Puppy – Pedigree Age over 4 months and under 12 months on Show Day. Handler any age

ALL PUPPIES MUST HAVE BEEN VACCINATED

Class 168. SPORTING BREEDS – PEDIGREE Dog or Bitch over 12 months. Handler any age

Class 169. NON SPORTING BREEDS – PEDIGREE . Dog or Bitch over 12 months. Handler any age

CLASSES 167,168 & 169 ARE RESTRICTED TO PEDIGREE DOGS & BITCHES

The winners of Classes 167,168 & 169 are then judged for The Port Askaig Cup for best in show with Runners up judged for Reserve best in Show

Class 170. ANY VARIETY CROSS BREED age 4 months & over on Show Day . Handler any age

A DOG/ BITCH CAN ONLY BE ENTERED IN ONE OF THE ABOVE CLASSES, BUT WILL BE ELIGIBLE TO ENTER CLASS 171

Class 171. JUNIOR HANDLER aged 16 years and under on Show Day , dog/bitch any age any breed over six months

ALL DOGS MUST BE EXAMINED BY VET AT ENTRANCE TO SHOWRING.
